



GRANTED CENSORSHIP POWERS WITHOUT JUDICIAL OR LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT IN TIMES OF EMERGENCY AS DETERMINED BY THE GOVERNMENT

"Power to intercept postal articles for public good. –(1) On the occurrence of any public emergency, or in the interest of the public safety or tranquility, the Central Government or a State Government, or any officer specially authorized in this behalf by the Central or the State Government may, by order in writing, direct that any postal article or class or description of postal articles in course of transmission by post shall be intercepted or detained or shall be disposed of in such manner as the authority issuing this order may direct"




