Nomination Form – Guidelines

Each year the Board of Governors elect an awardee for the Alfred F. Lichtenstein Memorial Award for Distinguished Service to Philately. This honor has celebrated philatelist who have made a significant contribution to philately, ever since Theodore E. Steinway was selected in 1952.

Any current member of The Collectors Club may submit a nomination for the Award

Criteria for Evaluation: In general, the nominee’s contributions in the categories below should be at the highest levels achieved in philately. Not all categories are likely to be equally weighted.

Philatelic Leadership: A strong sense of philatelic leadership is essential for this category. Accomplishments while acting as President, Board Chair or Member, or Committee Chair or Member of major national and international philatelic organizations should be described. Participation and contributions as a judge at the national and international levels should be noted here. The impact of the nominee’s contributions to philatelic organizations and to philately in general should be noted herein.

Philatelic Research and Publications: The nominee’s accomplishments in philatelic writing and editing should be noted. What new knowledge through research and publications has the nominee brought to philately and what impact has it had on philatelists? How successful has his/her Editorship been in attracting first rate articles to his/her journal, and how has the nominee’s efforts contributed to the overall success of the organization publishing the journal? Highlight books published by the nominee and note the impact of these on philately. Summarize the publication history of the nominee, and how it reflects on the nominee’s desire to share new knowledge with fellow philatelists.

Philatelic Exhibiting or Collecting Achievement: Has the nominee formed world-class collections and shared them with the philatelic world? Sharing could be via exhibitions, publications and/or lectures. For exhibitions, awards should be at the highest national and international levels. The material should be notable and exceptional, not simply good examples from well-established specialty areas. Publications relating to the nominee’s collections should be in journals of the top national and/or international quality, and lectures should include some of the most well-known venues.

Previous Honors and Awards: The awards and honors bestowed by other philatelic organizations or specialized societies are often an indication of an individual satisfying some of the criteria deserving of Lichtenstein recognition. Generally, Lichtenstein nominees will have received several significant national and/or international awards, and will have continued service and contributions to, philately.

Additional Information: Anything that the nominator believes is of importance to evaluating the nominee, but that is not present in the previous categories, should be included here.

Notes: *Nominations will remain active for a period of four years. Thereafter, a four-year renewal of the nomination may be submitted. Submitting members may provide update information on an annual basis.*
