


How to View and Interact with the Exhibits

Thank you for joining us at our first Virtual One-Frame Competition. There are several ways to view the exhibits.


Strolling the Hall allows you to view the exhibits as if you were walking down the Hall.

The Exhibit Gallery shows the first page of each Exhibit and allows you to search and comment on the Exhibits.



01 – Strolling the Hall

Scroll to an exhibit and click on and open individual pages or click on the “PDF” icon to view all the pages in PDF format in a separate tab. The PDF view is the best way to view exhibits with oversized pages.



You can increase the magnification of a page using a plus + or minus – sign, or magnifying glass setting in the URL bar. To return, select the RESET or close the page tab depending your browser capabilities.

02 – Gallery View

The Gallery View displays the first/title page of each exhibit.



When hovering over a page three icons will appear.

- Clicking on the “magnifying glass” will display the full title page. Clicking on the “X” on the page will return to the Gallery View.
- Clicking on the “heart” will open the Voting for the Holyoake Trophy – More on that later
- Clicking on the “Chain or butterfly” will display the complete exhibit similar to the exhibit display when strolling the hall



In the Gallery View you can view a new Exhibit by either returning to the Gallery which displays all exhibits or clicking the left and right navigation (< >) arrows.


03 – Interacting with the Exhibitor

LEAVE a REPLY: The Collectors Clubs encourages the social aspect of philately. While you cannot speak with the exhibitor and fellow viewers directly until November 4th, you can post comments about an exhibit in the “Leave a Reply” section at the bottom of each exhibit in the Gallery View.


Please remember we have multiple pages. You should select the Exhibit you want to view.

Both Members and non-members can comment on Exhibits. If you log on as a member you can simply leave your comments.

Non-members will need to enter their Name and Email Address. The Website field is optional.



04 – Voting for the Holyoake Friendship Trophy

As mentioned earlier the “heart icon” that appears upon hovering over the first/title page of each exhibit in the Gallery View will open the Voting for the Holyoake Trophy

In addition to the exhibit awards chosen by the exhibit jury, members can vote for their **favorite exhibit** for the Friendship Trophy. This award was created in 2010 at the behest of Collectors Club member Alan Holyoake of the United Kingdom, in celebration of the friendship between the Royal Philatelic Society London and the Collectors Club.



The Voting can be done through most views. You can vote wherever you see the heart icon. In **The Stroll Hall** the heart icon appears at the bottom of each exhibit page.



The Voting can be done through most views. You can vote wherever you see the heart icon. In **Gallery View** the heart icon appears at the top of each exhibit page.

Or the heart icon in the center of the icons when hovering over a page at the opening of the **Gallery View**.
